## CAMARADERIE

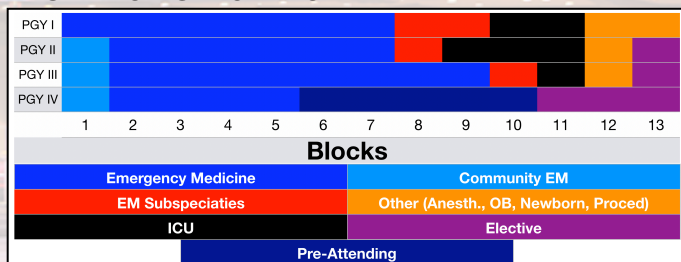
